Dear Supplier

In 2008 Amcor experienced two serious injuries associated with truck drivers working at our sites. In each of these cases the drivers were non-Amcor employees.

Amcor is committed to our No Injuries culture and we see the activities of truck drivers working at heights as very high risk. Consequently, we can no longer consider our current work practises as acceptable.

As a result Amcor Australasia is implementing a revised Truck Trailer Tray Fall Protection Policy. As with all Amcor Policies, the requirements with in the new Policy are mandatory and a copy of the new policy is attached for your reference. Failure to comply (post implementation period) will result in a request for the driver and vehicle to leave site and your load / unload activity will not be undertaken.

The major amendment to the Policy is that any Driver accessing the back of a Truck trailer or tray must wear a hard hat with a chin strap.

This Amcor Australasia Policy is to be implemented by the 15th June 2009 with full compliance by the end of July 2009; as per any other PPE requirement Drivers/Contractors will be required to provide their own hard hat suitably fitted with chin strap.

We believe we need to work in partnership with our logistics suppliers to achieve a paradigm shift in safety for transport loading / unloading safety at Amcor sites.

Your feedback is welcome and throughout the implementation of the policy it will be reviewed for its effectiveness.
